**Lenten Regulations
on Fasting and
Abstinence**

Ash Wednesday, February 14th and Good Friday, March 30th are days of fasting. On days of fast, one full meal and two lesser meals are allowed. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. Catholic between the ages of 18 years and 59 years are bound by this law. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday) night) adds the "paschal fast" to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection.

Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence. On days of abstinence, meat may not be taken. The law of abstinence binds all Catholics who have completed their 14th year.
