Choosing a Sponsor

- Each Candidate is to have one male or female sponsor for Confirmation (not their parent) over the age of 16.
- A sponsor must be a Catholic who has been confirmed, have already celebrated the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist, and lead a life in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken. The sponsor form completed by the sponsor's parish must be returned to OLOL.
- It is appropriate for the sponsor to be the Candidate's Godparent.
- The sponsor is to take care that the confirmed person behaves as a true witness of Christ and faithfully fulfills the obligations inherent in this sacrament.
- Sponsors should be present for Confirmation, for it is for the sponsor to see that the confirmed person acts as a true witness to Christ and faithfully fulfills the obligations connected with this sacrament. If a sponsor cannot be present, a proxy may stand in.
