Expectations of Incoming Year 2 Confirmandi

Curiosity about your faith

Courage to build community: to meet and talk with other Christians, young and old. Includes sharing meals with one another during youth ministry nights, and putting phones down during Youth Meetings, retreats, and conversations.

Commitment to participation in the life of the Church: weekend Mass, monthly adoration, Confession at minimum once per year, and at least one retreat experience per year. Show up for everything you can!

A heart of service: Willingly pitching in when asked and looking for ways to serve others when you are on campus. Courage to try new things you may not have tried before: Singing, lectoring, teaching, music, art, photography, design, making waffles, making popcorn, wiping tables, stacking chairs. Whatever, whenever!

Respect for the Church and its people, especially youth volunteers. Sticking to the rules that will keep you safe and out of trouble with the law and your parents. Honoring our sacred spaces – no phone use during the sacraments unless grave emergency.

Communicate well

▪ **Communication** is by email and text by Flocknote. Calendar will be on the Youth Ministry Page on ourladyoflight.com. Both students and parents bear the responsibility to open and read messages. You can always reach Youth Ministry staff at 239-267-7088 or email YouthMinistry@ourladyoflight.com. *We agree to communicate well with you about youth ministry at OLOL using Flocknote, and you agree to check messages regularly.*

Regular participation in the Mass

▪ **Regular participation in the Mass is an expectation of all individuals preparing to celebrate the sacraments.** The celebration of the Eucharistic Liturgy (Mass) is the central point around which parish life and Faith Formation flow. *We agree to welcoming you, teaching you, and encouraging your participation in the Mass. You agree to attending the 5pm Mass weekly, arriving 20 minutes before Mass to serve in the liturgy. If your student cannot come to Mass regularly (weekly), or regularly attends a different weekend Mass than the 5pm, please speak with the youth minister so we make a plan.*

Active participation in Youth Ministry

- **Fully Registered by August 1:** Submit this confirmation commitment form (p1-2) and registration (online on our website) to YouthMinistry@ourladyoflight.com. Additionally send in your student's **original and recent** Baptism Certificate (needs to be dated within the last year).
- Note the following diocesan expectations. Youth preparing for the celebration of sacraments this year:
 - Must also be registered in the Parish.
 - Must have actively participated in a Faith Formation program last year (or attend Catholic School)
 - Must actively participate in a Faith Formation program this year (Catholic School does not count for this)
 - Need 80% attendance in their Faith Formation program this year (Anchor in Faith: Confirmation Nights or Children's Faith Formation)
 - May not miss any sacramental preparations sessions
 - Attend Adoration monthly, Mass weekly, and have at least one retreat per year
- **Parents of OLOL Confirmation candidates** will be asked to serve in some way in the parish or in youth ministry. Please sign up for one of the following:
 - Confirmation Small group leader or assistant (_____)
 - Hospitality (assisting with snacks or meals) (_____)
